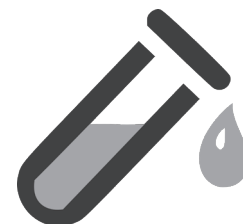

Please be sure to enter all information requested on the form. Incomplete forms will delay your registration or may be returned. All attendees must be pre-registered and paid in advance.

CONFIRMATION/ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF REGISTRATION: All participants who pre-register will receive a receipt/acknowledgement of their registration by mail. This acknowledgement will include specific information on the site and directions/map.

CERTIFICATES OF ATTENDANCE: All participants will receive a certificate of attendance at the conclusion of the event. This certificate will document attendance for use in demonstrating contact hours for professional growth requirements for certified water OR wastewater treatment operators.
